Prosecutor

Arguments for the prosecution:

- The CD was found in the defendant's bag. How did it get there if he/she didn't put it there?
- 2. Witnesses in the store say that they saw the defendant in the CD section of the store.
- 3. The main security camera shows the defendant in front of the section where the CD in question is kept.

Defense Lawyer

Arguments for the Defense:

- The defendant doesn't even like the music on the CD so there is no motive to steal it.
- 2. No one actually <u>saw</u> the defendant put the CD in the bag.
- 3. The defendant testifies that someone else must have put the CD in the bag because he/she did not. It is possible that someone could have done it.

<u>Judge</u>

After hearing both sides present the case I find the defendant <u>Guilty</u> of stealing the CD from the Music Store and sentence him/her to 1 year in prison.

#1 Surprise Evidence

Run up to the judge and say: Your honor, we just found a new security camera tape that recorded the crime from a different angle and it clearly shows someone else putting the CD in the defendant's bag when he/she wasn't looking!

(Give the judge the Response 2 paper)

Judge Response 2

This evidence was presented too late. My first decision stands. The defendant must go to jail.
